

## FAQ's - Devizes Sports Club AGM

Q:- Why has the AGM been delayed?

A:- The AGM had to be delayed because of COVID -19 and the restriction on numbers meeting inside. It was felt to be inappropriate to hold this meeting on Zoom or equivalent platform.

Q:- What effect has the pandemic had on the club and its finances?

A:- As you can imagine, the turnover fell dramatically, but the costs remained the same, therefore we had to modify the cost structure, which involved making staff redundant. The upshot of all this has helped reduce the costs of running the club and allowed the Clubs to look at running the club themselves.

Q:- When will the club be open to members?

A:- All sports can take place outside without the use of the clubhouse. We understand that from the 19 July, we can open the clubhouse and operations can start from there (subject to Government approval).

Q:- When will the club rent space for parties?

A:- As soon as the relaxation for the restricted numbers of people is lifted.

Q:- When will the bar be open?

A:- There will be a new plan to run the bar, which will be announced once finalised.

Q:- When will food be available?

A:- As above.

Q:- Going forward, how will the club be managed?

A:- From this AGM, the old Committee will be replaced by the three Chairs and co-opted members. They will run the club with the specific remit of creating a constitution to fit the change proposed, providing a set of working parameters that cater for all. They will look at how the Clubs perform, and make suggestions for the future running of the club by 31st March 2022.
